Ontario Arts Council

The Ontario Arts Council (OAC) is an agency of the Government of Ontario established in 1963 with a mandate to foster the creation and production of art for the benefit of all Ontarians. The OAC provides grants and services to professional Ontario-based artists and arts organizations.

A 12-person volunteer board of directors, appointed by Ontario's Lieutenant Governor in Council, oversees OAC's policies and governance.

General Records and Personal Information

- Communications Records
 - Includes records relating to: public relations, publication production, promotions, events, and other general communication files.
- Corporate Records
 - Includes records relating to: the Director & CEO, Board of Directors, research and strategic planning.
- Finance and Administrative Records
 - Includes records relating to: accounting, payroll, budgets, facilities, procurement, and systems.
- Granting Records
 - Includes records relating to: applications, assessors, outreach and development.
- Human Resources Records
 - Includes records relating to: recruitment, personnel files, training and development, labour relations, health and safety, etc.
