Over the next few months, your son/daughter will be involved in an “Arts” initiative called Arts Infused Learning (AIR). Arts Infused Learning is a provincial initiative, aimed at promoting active participation of young people in the arts. Arts Infused Learning projects combine student learning of traditional subjects - social studies, languages, history, culture - with a variety of artistic disciplines: visual art; literary art; dance; music; theatre. An Artist from the community assists in delivering the artistic discipline by collaborating with the teacher and working directly with the students in the classroom.

The project will help us assess the impact of arts-infused learning on the engagement, motivation, attendance and academic achievement of students. Photographs and video will be taken as each project progresses, and it is the intention of the Durham District School Board to share the successes of these board-wide projects by displaying them at the school and Education Centre, and posting the photographs and video on the DDSB website, Ontario Arts Council and other partner websites (e.g., Whitby Station Gallery, Robert McLaughlin Art Gallery).
