Family Art Jamboree Workshop Selections

Artist and Workshop Title	Age Group (Grade)	Length of workshop
<p>Pottery with Aimee Baldwin of Moon in June Studio 16 people maximum (8 child/adult pairs) Participants will create an object out of clay; they will learn some basics of working with clay and get a feel for this tactile, three dimensional art form. Participants will also get to add colour to their finished pieces using special clay paint. Finished products will be taken to Moon In June Studio to be glazed/fired and will be ready for pick up in 2-3 weeks.</p>	Grades K-3	45 minutes
<p>Pottery with Aimee Baldwin of Moon in June Studio 16 people maximum (8 child/adult pairs) Participants will create an object out of clay; they will learn some basics of working with clay and get a feel for this tactile, three dimensional art form. Participants will also get to add colour to their finished pieces using special clay paint. Finished products will be taken to Moon In June Studio to be glazed/fired and will be ready for pick up in 2-3 weeks.</p>	Grades 4-6	1 hr 30 min
<p>Suncatcher Silhouette Tree of Life with Adrienne Jeswiet 20 people maximum (10 child/adult pairs) Make, bake, and take your own polymer clay art creation! Participants will learn a bit about polymer clay, its uses, and how to create some textured surfaces.</p>	Grades 3-6	1 hr 30 min
<p>Ink Tile Painting with Marion McKay 16 people maximum (8 child/parent pairs) Create colourful one of a kind coasters using inks, glazed tiles and rubbing alcohol. Each tile turns out uniquely different which makes this project especially fun! Watch in wonder as the creation unfolds before your eyes.</p>	Grade 3-6	45 minutes
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<p>Fuzed Glass with Betty Wires of Midnight Loon Glass 8 people maximum (4 child/adult pairs) Spring is here...time to think about gardening! In this session, you will learn to make fused glass garden stakes. These stakes are a wonderful way to add colour to your outdoor gardens and potted plants.</p>	Grades 5 & 6	45 minutes
<p>Jigging and Square Dancing with Howard Copenace 20 people maximum (10 child/adult pairs) In this workshop you will learn the basic steps for jigging and square dancing and have fun dancing with your partner!</p>	Grades K-6	45 minutes
<p>Drumming with Teddy Copenace Girls – 12 maximum (6 child/adult pairs) Boys – 10 maximum (5 child/adult pairs) Learn about basic traditional drumming in this hands on exploration of beat and song for the contemporary drum (the big drum) and the hand drum.</p>	Grades K-6	45 minutes
<p>Beading with Rachel Copenace and Shelly Tom 20 people maximum (10 child/adult pairs) In this workshop you will learn basic traditional beading techniques and create a beaded project.</p>	Grades K-2	45 minutes
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<p>Papermaking with Susie Brown 8 people maximum (4 child/adult pairs) Participants will learn how to make paper from a cotton fibre base or recycled paper. We will include natural materials into our papers, and there will be craft materials available to decorate the final piece of paper or card. This eco-friendly project is a great follow up to Earth Day!</p>	Grades K-6	45 minutes
<p>Tissue Paper Overlay with Irene McCuaig 20 maximum (10 child/adult pairs) Participants will use torn tissue paper to create a woodland or lakeside image. This is an exploration of how layers of tissue paper can create new colours, and how torn tissue can be used to create different shapes. Taken together, these elements will form a beautiful landscape.</p>	Grades 3-6	1 hr 30 minutes

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<p>Zumba Dance with Jasmine Wild 16 maximum (8 child/adult pairs) Learn to dance through repetitive fun movements. Moving to music is a great way to develop the body and the mind. Explore fun rhythms and choreography to familiar pop songs that the whole family will love.</p>	Grades 3-6	45 minutes
<p>Creative Movement with Jasmine Wild 16 maximum (8 child/adult pairs) Children have wonderful imaginations and a thirst for learning. Through Creative Movement they will develop physically, mentally, emotionally, and socially. One of the best ways to stimulate their creativity is by getting them up and moving. Have fun during this session learning about and exploring movement together with your child!</p>	Grades K-2	45 minutes
<p>Cardmaking 101 with Natasha Tsevende 12 maximum (6 child/adult pairs) Learn about stamps, colouring, and design, and have fun creating some dynamic cards! You will have the chance to make 2 - 4 cards to take home with you.</p>	Grades K-6	45 minutes
<p>Smashbook with Natasha Tsevende 12 maximum (6 child/adult pairs) A Smashbook is a quick and easy "scrapbook" - you are encouraged to work quick, scribble, doodle and just get your memories and pictures on the page! We will work through a single page. Please bring up to 10 pictures of a single event and/or some memorabilia (tickets, etc) to make your page.</p>	Grades K-6	45 minutes
<p>Photography with David White 10 maximum (5 child/adult pairs) Portraits Like a Pro! Move beyond the snapshot and learn how to use natural light to create flattering portraits with impact. We'll cover controlling light, posing, selecting backgrounds and using basic equipment like phones, tablets and point and shoot cameras for great results. Session will take place out of doors unless there is inclement weather. Please dress appropriately for the weather. Each participant is required to bring some type of device that has a digital camera that can be viewed on a screen (DSLR camera, point and shoot camera, ipod with camera, tablet with camera, phone with camera, etc)</p>	Grades 3-6	1 hr 30 mins
<p>Film making with Matt Kennedy 8 maximum (4 child/adult pairs) Learn about the art of filmmaking! This will be a collaborative workshop, with all participants exploring together the basics of acting in scenes and supporting as film crew in the creation of a single product.</p>	Grades 4-6	1 hr 30 mins
