What is Arts Infused Learning?

• The Arts Infused Learning program offers Durham Students a unique opportunity to learn curriculum through The Arts - visual art, literary art, dance, music and theatre.

What is an Arts Infused Learning Project?

- All projects are based on learning curriculum (math, history, science, language, etc.) through a medium of the arts (visual art, music, drama, dance, literary art, etc.).
- Teachers are partnered and collaborate with professional artists to deliver curriculum through an arts-infused learning environment.
- Students are *actively engaged* in *discovering* knowledge through artistic experiences in which they are creating, experimenting, observing, reflecting, presenting and responding.

How do I become involved in a Project?

- Teachers decide which **curriculum** area or area(s) they want to target (i.e. language, math, science, geography, history, sociology, chemistry, physics, etc.)
- Proposals will be reviewed by the Principal and the AIL Project Coordinator, Angela Davis.
- The proposal form is to be completed, signed by your principal, and returned to Angela Davis on or before **Friday**, **November 4**, **2016**. The proposal form can be found below.
